At the age of 13, I disclosed years of sexual abuse by my stepfather. *"When did the abuse start, how old were you, how many times did it happen?"* I felt intense fear that people would not believe me because I could not give the answers to these seemingly simple questions. The reality is that my brain did not file the memory of the first incident, or subsequent incidents of abuse as a biographical memory where the date and incident number were important.




