When Love Hurts: A Look at the Realities of Intimate Partner Violence In the 1970s and 1980s, women's rights groups elevated the voices and raised awareness of crimes committed against wives by their husbands. In response to the campaigns, domestic violence shelters opened for women seeking refuge from their abusive husbands. Largely, people viewed domestic violence as a gendered issue- one where married women were the victims.


